Aspen Meadows Resort *Aspen, Colorado*

A 40-acre meadow along the Roaring Fork River is the serene setting for this Bauhaus-style resort, originally dreamt up by Austrian artist-cum-architect Herbert Bayer for the deep thinkers of the Aspen Institute. Stark white square facades and glass walls distinguish the resort's 22,000-square-foot, Gold LEED-certified Doerr-Hosier Center, a favorite venue for breakout brainstorming and keynote speeches. Between sessions, clear your mind in the property's modern art gallery, or stroll through aspen groves to installations like Bayer's 1957 *Kaleidoscreen* and 1955 *Marble Garden*. Just leave time for the Aspen Valley's inspiring seasonal splendor: wildflower hikes and fly-fishing in the summer and fall, and a four-mountain ski resort network
